Recipe is compliments of Mary Cron at 6602 Mohawk Trail.

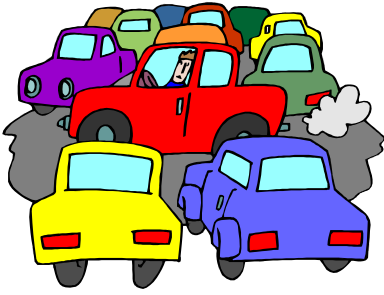
